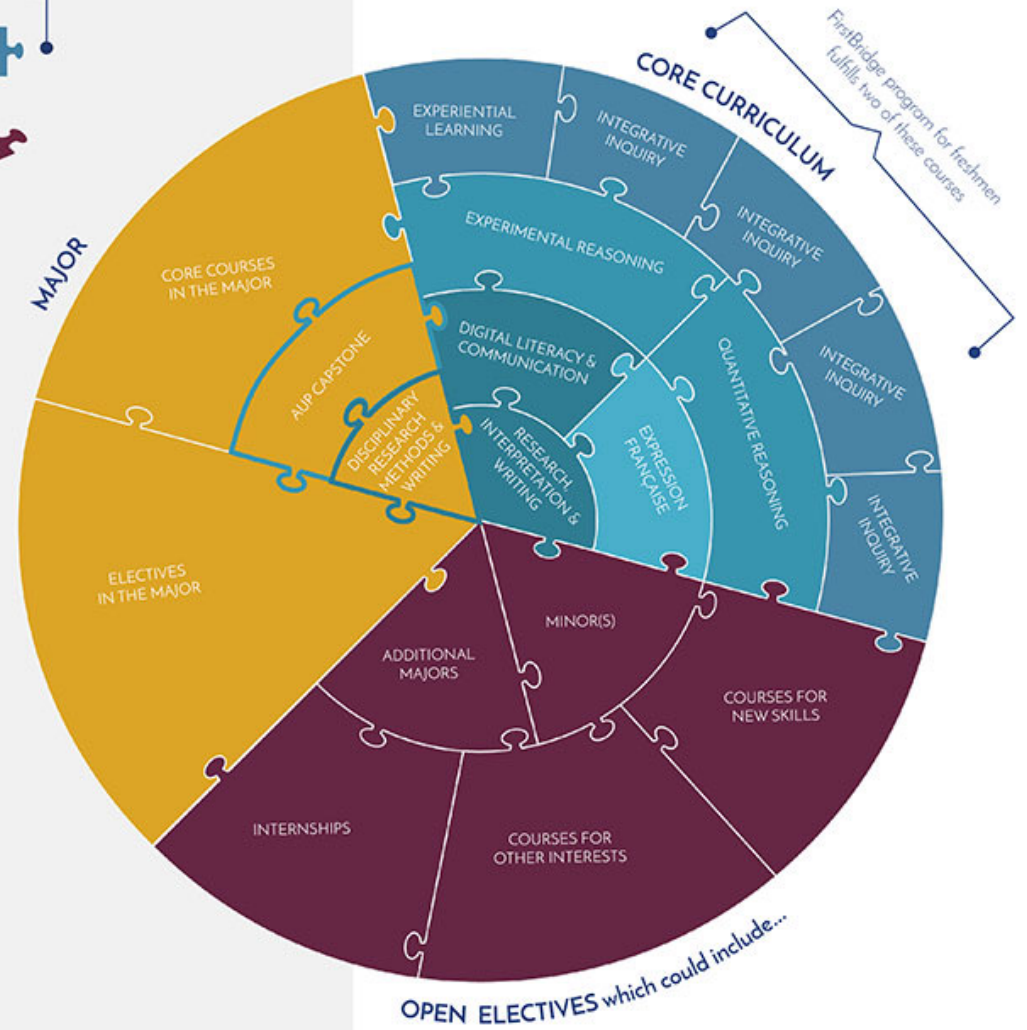
In The Classroom
